# CHANCES

## *Parent Support Group*

CHANCES to meet other families who have children with an Autism Spectrum Disorder.

CHANCES to learn from a clinician who has specialized training in the area of Autism Spectrum Disorders.

CHANCES to share information about resources you and other families have found useful.

CHANCES to build a network of support.

CHANCES to learn new approaches.

CHANCES to access Workshops and Conferences.



## *Respite*

CHANCES for you to partner with trained support staff who will serve your child.

CHANCES for you to teach the staff about your child and what works for your family.

CHANCES for you to go to stores, parks, parties, restaurants, or family gatherings without worry that you will have to leave early. Minor disruptions don't have to become major productions. Your staff can provide the individualized attention your child needs, or bring them home when necessary.

CHANCES staff will work with you to set a schedule of respite that works for you and your family.

CHANCES respite can be provided when you are home so you can read, take a bath, mow the lawn or just relax.

CHANCES respite gives you time to get out of the house to run errands or just enjoy some needed time away.

CHANCES staff can take your child out to experience activities of interest in the community.
